SUMMARY

The Israelites, enslaved in Egypt, cry out to God, who raises up Moses to confront Pharaoh and demand their release. After ten devastating plagues and the miraculous parting of the Red Sea, the Israelites escape Egypt, beginning their journey toward freedom and covenant with God.

Oppression In Egypt

- Israelites oppressed by a new Pharaoh who rose up and enslaved them. - Exodus 1:1-22

Moses' Preparation

- Moses born, hidden for three months and then adopted by Pharaoh's daughter. - Exodus 2:1-10
- Moses kills an Egyptian for hitting a Hebrew and then flees to Midian, where he marries Zipporah - Exodus 2:11-22
- Moses now a shepherd, turns a side to see the burning bush and encounters God, who sends him back to Egypt to deliver His people from Pharaoh Exodus 3:1-10

Moses Confronts Pharaoh

- Pharaoh refuses to let the Israelites go and increases their labour - Exodus 5:1-21
- God sends ten plagues upon Egypt to compel Pharaoh to release the Israelites - Exodus 7:14-12:30
 - Water turns to blood - Exodus 7:14-24
 - Frogs - Exodus 8:1-15
 - Gnats - Exodus 8:16-19
 - Flies - Exodus 8:20-32
 - Death of livestock - Exodus 9:1-7
 - Boils - Exodus 9:8-12
 - Hail - Exodus 9:13-35
 - Locusts - Exodus 10:1-20
 - Darkness - Exodus 10:21-29
 - Death of the firstborn - Exodus 11:1-12:30

Passover

- Israelites instructed by God to sacrifice a Lamb and paint the door posts with the blood of the lamb Ex. 12:4-12
- Destroying angel passes over Egypt and the first born males of every household without the blood on the door post dies at midnight - Exodus 12:29-30

Crossing the Red Sea

- Pharaoh's army pursues the Israelites. Moses parts the Red Sea, allowing the Israelites to cross on dry ground, and the sea returns, drowning the Egyptian army - Exodus 14:1-31
- The Israelites celebrate their deliverance with a song of praise - Exodus 15:1-21

KEY POINTS

1. What started out as a haven for the Israelites in now a prison, the Lord hears the cry of their heart deliverance and sends Moses.
2. God demonstrates his power in bringing ten plagues against Pharaoh and the Egyptian people.
3. The Israelites are miraculously delivered through the parting of the red sea.
