SUMMARY

Jesus' words in the New Testament reveal divine wisdom, compassion, and authority—teaching love, forgiveness, and the coming of God's Kingdom through parables and sermons. His works, including healing the sick, calming storms, and rising from the dead, demonstrate his power over nature, sin, and death, affirming his identity as the Son of God.

NOTES

Words of Jesus:

- Sermon on the Mount: Jesus teaches about the Beatitudes, the Lord's Prayer, and teachings about sin and righteousness, revealing His authority and wisdom - Matthew 5-7
- Parables: Jesus uses parables to teach about the Kingdom of God, such as:
 - The Parable of the Sower - Matthew 13:1-23
 - The Parable of the Good Samaritan - Luke 10:25-37
 - The Parable of the Prodigal Son - Luke 15:11-32
- "I Am" Statements: Jesus makes several "I Am" statements in John's Gospel, revealing His divine nature:
 - "I am the Bread of Life" - John 6:35
 - "I am the Light of the World" - John 8:12
 - "I am the Good Shepherd" - John 10:11
 - "I am the Resurrection and the Life" - John 11:25
 - "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life" - John 14:6
- Teaching on Love: Jesus emphasizes the greatest commandments: to love God and love others - Matthew 22:37-40

Works of Jesus:

- Miracles: Jesus performs numerous miracles that demonstrate His power and compassion, such as:
 - Turning water into wine at Cana - John 2:1-11
 - Healing the blind, lame, and lepers - Mark 2:1-12; Luke 17:11-19; John 9:1-7
 - Feeding the 5,000 with five loaves and two fish - Matthew 14:13-21
 - Walking on water - Matthew 14:22-33
 - Raising Lazarus from the dead - John 11:1-44
- Casting Out Demons: Jesus casts out demons, showing His authority over evil spirits - Mark 1:21-28; Luke 8:26-39
- Forgiving Sins: Jesus forgives sins, an act that demonstrates His divine authority - Mark 2:1-12; Luke 7:48-50
- The work of Jesus were done testified that He came from the Father and the Father was in him. - John 10:38

1. The words of Jesus teach us the love, grace and nearness of God's Kingdom
2. His works not only revealed his divine power, but also revealed the deeply compassionate heart of Father God.
3. Both Jesus' words and works testified that he was the Messiah.
